Spanish Lessons: Five sessions per week, each session is 3 hours duration. There will be an initial language assessment and students will be tutored according to ability. Our teachers are qualified, native speakers.

Discover Alcala de los Gazules: A walking tour through the winding Moorish streets to places of interest, an opportunity to learn about the rich history, geography and culture of this beautiful Pueblo Blanco (white town).

Alcornocales Park Visitor Centre & El Aljibe Botanic Gardens: Los Alcornocales Natural Park stretches from the east of the province of Cadiz to the west of Malaga province. It includes a series of mountain ranges that are home to the largest cork oak grove on the Iberian Peninsula and one of the most important in the world. This forest is perfectly conserved and is one of the most exemplary examples of Mediterranean forests. The Botanic Gardens are aimed at preserving the local endemic flora, and specialises in the plant-life within the Alcornocales Natural Park and the southern tip of Spain. This is a small and informative garden covering about 1 hectare on the western edge of the Los Alcornocales oak forest. The gardens are well labelled with information not just about the plants but also the rock structures and terrain that support them.

Baelo Claudia Roman Town and Museum: Excavations have revealed the most comprehensive remains of a Roman town in Spain, with monuments such as the basilica, the theatre, the market, and the temple of Isis. It is set in the spectacular scenery in the Straits of Gibraltar Natural Park, which meets the sea at Bolonia Beach offering a view of North Africa in the near distance. Bolonia Beach is sandy and the sea safe to swim in. There are small several small bars and restaurants near by for lunch and refreshments.

Nuestra Señora de los Santos Shrine dates back to the fourteenth century, it owes its current trace to the seventeenth century. Interestingly, in the Sanctuary remains the largest and most interesting collection of ex-votos (vow made in gratitude or devotion) of Andalucía. Thousands of objects, including paintings in which the faithful have shown that grace in the intercession of the Virgin has been granted to them, hang up and crowd the walls of the sanctuary.
